1	After a touchdown the scoring team will have the choice of kicking off.
2	The penalty for appearing late for the start of the 1 st or 3 rd quarters in 10 yard penalty, no option.
3	Over time the home team will have the choice of (1) offense or defense (2) end of field.
4	Following a time out by Team B, play is stopped for illegal procedure by Team A. Team B declines the yardage. Will the clock start when the ball is ready for play.
5	Following a Team A time out, many Team A players remain near the bench , Team a should be penalized 5 yards for illegal procedure applied at PLS down repeated.
6	Team A captain may request an unlimited number of stoppages in putting the ball into play due to crowd noise.
7	On the last play of the half, team B score a safety touch. The referee awards Team B one more play.
8	On the last play of the game Team B go offside and the play is whistled dead, do the options allow Team A hold the start of the clock or start the clock at the snap
9	If Team A commit UR foul on the last play of the game, can Team B have an option of ending the game?
10	On the last play of the 1 st half, Team A scores a touchdown with Team B called for a Face Mask infraction. Team A's options are (1) have the penalty applied on the convert or (2) on a Team A kick off to extend the half.
11	On 2 nd D Team A fumble the ball from their end zone to OB at the A5. Team B given a safety touch, no option.
12	Team A receiver running along the sideline steps OB and then continuing down the sideline catches a pass. Team B option is to allow the play or Team A loss 10 yd DR.
13	On a kickoff Team A player runs OB to avoid a block. The Team A player then reenters the field of play and touches the loose ball. Is Team B entitled to the ball at that point.
14	Team A 1D and 10 runs a play which gains 12 yards. A 31 is detected with hazardous equipment. Team B captain insists on applying the penalty at PLS, not PBD. Is his request is legitimate?
15	On a convert from the 5yd line Team A is called for a second no mouth guard or objectionable conduct. The penalty will be applied on the kickoff.

16	A6 fumbles the ball at the Team B 8 yard line. the ball hits B45 at the B3 yard line and then goes OB in the B end zone. No score. The ball is awarded to Team A at the B 8 yard line.
17.	A15 fumbles the ball at the A 3 yard line and B46 knocks the ball into the Team A end zone where the ball goes dead in Team A's possession. One point for Team B, Team A scrimmage on A35.
18	A25 reports in as an ineligible receiver and lines up at left guard on 2D and 3. The play is stopped. A25 stays in at the same position for the next play. This is illegal and Team B would have the option of an Illegal procedure penalty applied at PLS down repeated.
19	Kick Off less than 10 yards. A54 touches the ball, B38 touches the ball and A78 recovers the ball and advances it to the B35 yard line where he fumbles and Team B recovers and returns the ball to the Team A 10 yard line. In total Team B has 3 options available.
20	Team A 3 rd D 20 @Team B 35 punt. Team B called for UR with ball in flight. Can Team A decline the point have Team B scrimmage 1D@ Team B5 yard line.
21	Team B fumble a punt in the Team B end zone. A56 holds B34 to allow A26 to recover the loose ball. Ball will awarded to Team B at the B10 no score.
22	Team A scrimmage2D @A12. QB A14 fumbles the ball into the end zone. B46 holds A54 in his attempt to recover the ball and B46 recovers the ball in the end zone. No score, Team A 1D@A10.
23	B36 intercepts a FP in the Team B end zone. While the ball is in the Team B end zoneA78 commits UR on B56.in the Team B end zone. The ball goes dead at the Team B 5 yard line. The penalty will be applied from the Team B 10 yard line. Team B 1D@B25.
24	Team A 2D 10 @A35, fumble the ball. A56 preventsB34 from recovering the ball at the A24 yard line by grasping the face mask. Ball goes dead at the Team A 20 yard line in Team A possession. Does Team B have the option of Team B1D at the PBD?
25	Team A 1D10 on Team B 10. A54 is offside. B67commits UR .Dual foul penalties adjusted at the PLS and the difference applied resulting in Team A ball at the B1
26	Team A punt. B36 touches the ball, A54 touches the ball, and B36, while trying to recover the ball, runs OB. B36 turns to come back in bounds , reaches over the side line and touches the ball while his feet still are OB. Play whistled dead and ball awarded to Team A

27	A35 kickoff. A72 goes OB to avoid a block and gets down field and jumps on the ball. Team B will be awarded the ball where A72 recovered the ball
28	B56 goes off side and contacts A67. The play is whistled dead before the snap. Team B had 13 players on the field. This is a double foul.
29	Team A has punted the ball downfield and it bounces backwards. The kicker A23, coming downfield, clearly enters the 5 yard restraining zone before any of his team mates. A46, who is behind A23 and also inside the restraining zone, does not try to withdraw and falls on the ball on the Team B 25 yard line. Team A 1 st D
30	A13 punts the ball on 3D. The ball crosses the LS in the air and is blown back by the wind and is caught by offside A46 behind the LS. Team B only option is to take the ball at the point of origin of the pass
